### **Goat Rotation – Livelihood Programme for the Rural Poor Women**

Report period: April 2016 to March 2017

#### **Brief Introduction**

Tiruvannamalai district is a declared drought prone district where the Dalit women and landless agricultural labourers are being deprived of their livelihood resources. The Dalit women from the district of Tiruvannamalai are the most oppressed and discriminated as they are subjugated to caste atrocities, violence against women including domestic violence. Dalit villages are denied basic amenities, the right to dignified living, right to education, equality and entitlement and their very right to survival is being challenged.

RWDS initiated the project “Strengthening the Dalit Women Movement” in 20 villages of Tiruvannamalai with the support from ECOMWELL. The project aims to enhance their economic status and thereby to enhance the equality of status of women as participants, decision-makers and beneficiaries in the democratic, economic, social and cultural spheres of life.

This report is a consolidation of activities carried out during the year covering a period April 2016 to March 2017

#### **Goal of the Project**

Enabling the rural poor Dalit women movement members to attain financial independence through mobilization of local capacities and optimum utilization of external resources that the communities can gain access to

## Objectives

- To facilitate a process for enhancing the economic situation of Dalit women movement members
- To develop livelihood activities among dalit women which they can themselves effectively manage, and which can augment incomes and provide employment in the area.

## Milks Cows-IGA

Support was given to women involved in collective farming for purchase of cows under IGA. The beneficiaries were repaying the money in 10 installments of Rs. 3000 each per month. From the reimbursed money, another 35 beneficiaries were supported with an amount of Rs.30000/- each during the reporting period for purchase of cows. The beneficiaries were required to produce documentary supports. After submission of basic required documents, money was deposited in the individual bank accounts. Each beneficiary was given a cheque to the tune of Rs. 30000/- each. They withdrew the money and purchased cows. Tokens were issued and the cows were insured.

I am Unnamalai from Kallaraipady village of Tiruvannamalai district. I am married to Mr. Ramasamy and we have four children two girls and two boys. We work as agriculture coolie workers since we do not own any land. I got an opportunity to start income generation activity when RWDS supported with Rs 30000/- under the ECOMWEL project of catering milk cows. With the money I put additional money and bought a cow from the market. I took care of the cow and the cow delivered a male calf. I am able to sell 7 liters of milk every day.

I am able to earn Rs. 3000 to 4000 per month. I use the money for family needs for repaying the loan I am able to earn around Rs.3000/- per month. I am using the money for the family needs and for savings. I am respected in the family. I am thankful to ECOMWEL and RWDS for helping our family.



2. Alamelu w/o Murugan

I am Alamelu resident of Mottur village. I hail from a very poor family. I am married and we have two sons through our matrimonial life. We eke out our living by working as coolie labor. As our work has been very seasonal we find very difficult to take care of the financial needs of the family. While so I got an opportunity to participate in the training organized by RWDS. After the training I was given support money of Rs.30000/- towards purchase of milking cow. I invested an additional 2000 for buying a cow. I have been catering the cow well. The cow has given birth to a female calf. The cow gives around 10 liters of milk every day. I sell 9 liters of milk. I am able to earn Rs. 4000 to 5000 per month. I used the money for family needs for repaying the loan and for the education of my sons who are still in school. I sold the first calf and with that money bought 4 goats and I am taking care of the cow and goats. I have cleared the loan. My income has increased. I am thankful to RWDS and to ECOMWEL for helping me to enhance my income and recognition in family and social status.



3. Bhoopathi w/o Kanakambaram

I am living at Nathavady village with my husband and youngest son. All other 5 children are married and are living separately. I am from a poor family and with difficulty I have been taking care of the family. I was selected as one of the beneficiaries under the ECOMWEL supported RWDS facilitated goat rotation scheme. I received Rs.4000/- and I invested additional Rs.1000/- and purchased goat. The goat gave birth to a female lamb. I gave the lamb to the organization as was the agreement. After which the goat gave birth three times. On each occasion the goat gave birth to two lambs each. I sold the lambs for Rs.10000/- and I invested the money for construction of house under the government welfare scheme. The goat gave birth again. Now I have 8 goats. I am able to earn, sell whenever required and get money. I take care of the goats and have a plan of increasing the numbers and want to make a real asset of the goats.
